

Key Stage 2 SATS Results Comparison

In May, the Year 6 children sat exams that are designed to check individual pupils' and schools' attainment and progress, in comparison with national data.

The tests check pupils' understanding in Maths (Arithmetic and Reasoning), Reading and Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS).

Pupils receive a scaled score between 80-120. Scores of 100 or above show that a pupil has met the expected standard for the KS2 tests. Scores of 110 can be interpreted as 'working at a greater depth' or 'exceeding expectations'.

We are incredibly proud of how hard our pupils work and the results that they achieve and as Lady Lane Park School is completely non-selective, this makes our academic success all the more pleasing.
