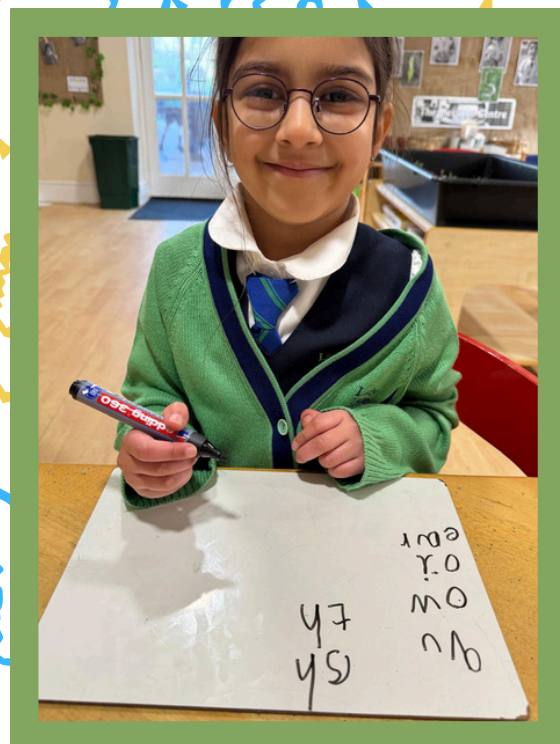
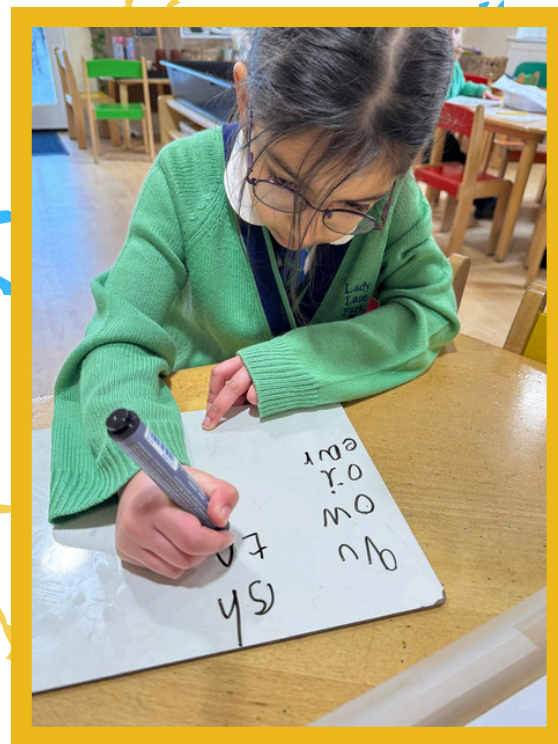
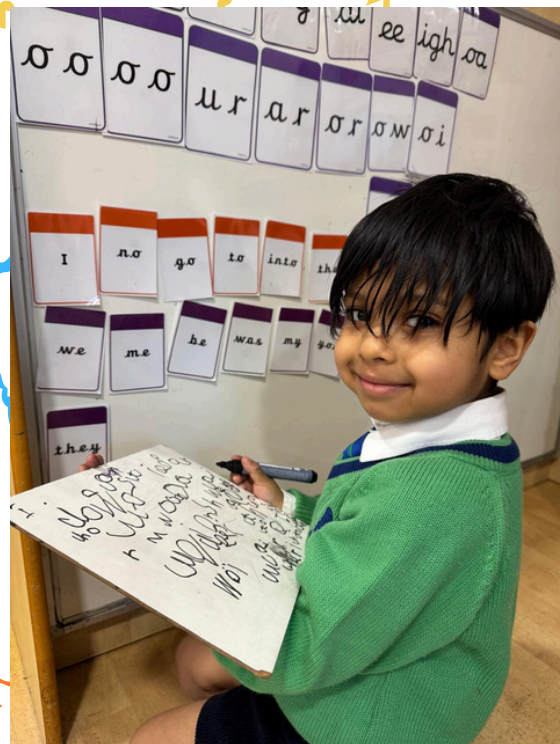

# School Rules

Treat everyone with kindness, understanding, and empathy. Show respect to your teachers, peers, and all members of our school community.

Listen carefully, share, and work together to create a happy school environment.

## 2. Work Hard and Aim High

Always put your best effort into your studies and activities. Approach challenges with a positive attitude and a willingness to learn. Strive to do your best every day, aiming high in everything you do.

## 3. Act Responsibly and Be a Good Role Model

Take responsibility for your actions and decisions. Be a role model for others by demonstrating good behaviour and integrity.

Help others, be honest, and take care of your belongings and the environment.

Show consideration for others in our local community and beyond.

Help create a safe and inclusive environment for all.

Make good choices and support your classmates and teachers.

## 4. Represent Our School with Pride

Wear the school uniform with pride, ensuring it is neat and tidy at all times.

Follow the school rules inside and outside of school to represent our values.

Be a positive ambassador Lady Lane Park whenever you are in the community or representing the school at events.

# School Rules

## During the School Day

### Playtime Behaviour

- You must play safely without hurting anyone.
- We do not 'play fight' because we may hurt someone by accident. You must be kind, by including people in your games and sharing equipment.
- When called, you must line up in your lining up order quickly

### Lunchtime

- When called, you must line up in their lining up order quickly.
- You should use a quiet voice in the dinner hall.
- You should finish what you are eating before leaving your seat.
- EVERYONE uses good manners during lunchtime, particularly when receiving food from the school kitchen and talking to staff.
- Good manners' means saying 'please' when you ask for something and 'thank you' when you receive it.

### End of the day routine

Pupils must:

- Know to stay in a straight line while walking out of school.
- Know that they must not go home until the teacher has checked that the correct adult is picking them up
- Know that these procedures are put in place to keep all children safe at home time.

### Attendance and Punctuality

Pupils must:

- Know that they must try to attend school every day.
- Know that they must try to arrive at school on time every day.
- Know that attending school on time every day is important so that they don't miss important learning.

### Preventing Bullying

Pupils must know that bullying is:

- Hurting someone else on purpose
- Repetitive – it happens again and again
- Can be physical, verbal, and emotional

Know that bullying can be indirect. This means:

- Leaving people out of groups or games
- Talking about someone behind their back
- Standing by and watching someone get bullied without letting an adult know

Know that if this happens online, it is called cyberbullying

Know that if you think you are being bullied you should tell an adult.

Know that if you think someone is being bullied you should tell an adult.

Know that **bullying is unacceptable**

and that it will be dealt with seriously by all adults at Lady Lane Park School.

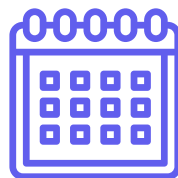
